

[Tools needed]

craft bond glue, utility knife, cutting mat, scissors, tweezers, ruler, pencils, toothpick, nippers, eyeleteer, needle-nose pliers, round-nose pliers

[Not necessary but convenient]

tray for parts, glue stick, wet wipes, papers

[Materials included]



* Image printed on instruction may have a certain level of color difference to the actual object. * The actual object may have certain differences compared with the image printed here. * For materials in this kit, their colors, shapes, sizes and pattern may vary, due to manufacturing process. Natural wooden plate are naturally generated, their colors and wood grain will not be identical. * The wooden plate may be warped slightly because of the excessive humidity.

[About Preserved moss and flowers]

* Preserved moss and flowers may get on your clothes, wall or floor. * if they are exposed to fluorescent light or direct sunshine for long time, the colors may fade. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight. * Depending on the season, the colors, shapes and sizes of moss and flowers may vary. * This product is specially for craft. Do not eat.

Read the following before you start.

* Please check if the contents are all included. * Please follow the TIP, reference information, and images for your reference.

*** You will need:**

- a wooden stick...to use bond glue.
- a wet towel... to wipe your hands and to clean your place.
- a paper... when using bond glue and not to get dirty.
- tweezers... for detail work.

A glue gun is also useful instead of a bond glue.

* Please adjust the length of natural flowers and preserved moss based on the place where you want to use it. Divide the materials and dry run before finally fixing to the products.

* Printed images may be come off when rubbing the paper parts with an eraser or a wet towel.

Craft band



Ensure use the correct color of band for each design element.

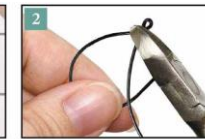
*The craft bands vary slightly in width or the number of twisted paper strings, depending on their colors.

Curve the wire

Bending in the opposite direction which has been bended makes it being deformed or split.



Curve the wire referring to the pattern sheet with your fingers or pliers.



Cut off the excess with nippers.

POINT

Roll into a circle



Wrap it around a pen.

Curve the edge



Pinch the edge with Pliers and bend it.

Paste Paper parts on one side.

* When you work on, please refer to the numbers printed here. Only numbers are printed in HOW TO MAKE section instead of parts name.

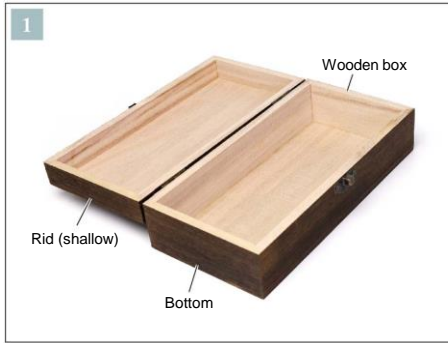


Caution!

Unlock the wooden box and place it with the rid open.
*Place something under the rid so that the rims of the rid and bottom are horizontal.



Cut out paper parts.

POINT Wooden box may be warped because it is a natural product. When pasting paper parts inside the box, measure the sizes where you would like to paste and cut the paper parts to fit them.

Cut the parts (2~4, 7~9) which will be pasted on 1~2mm shorter than actual size.
Gap

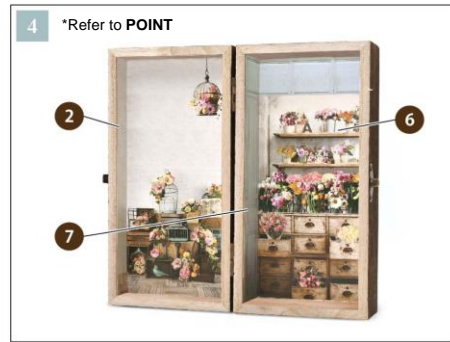
Rid (shallow) Bottom (deep)

Paste inside the Rid Paste inside the Bottom

Align ★ to the inner corners of the wooden box.



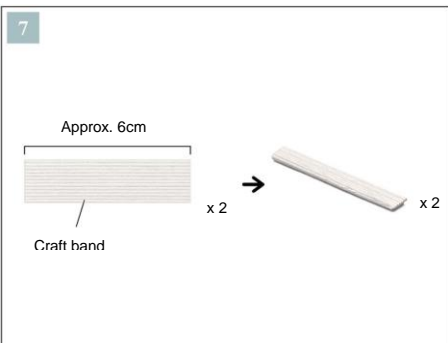
Cut out 1 to fit



Paste each part in the same way as 3



*Refer to POINT



Cut the craft band into approx. 6cm x 2 pieces. Apply the glue and fold them in half.



Paste 7 on 6



Cut out the paper parts, and paste them on tiles as shown in the picture above.

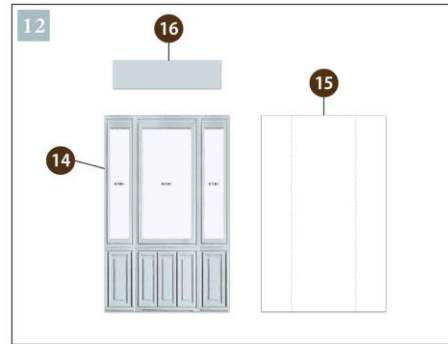


Paste each part together.

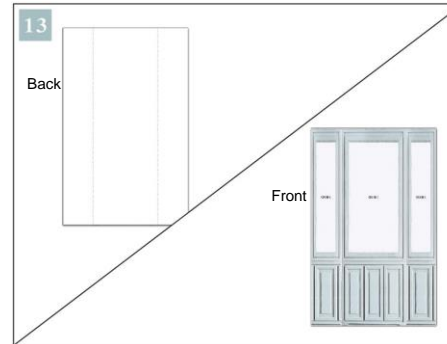


Paste plants as shown in the picture above.

*Plants are used in 3d ~ 3d
*Cut the plants into an appropriate length and divide into some bunches for your convenience.



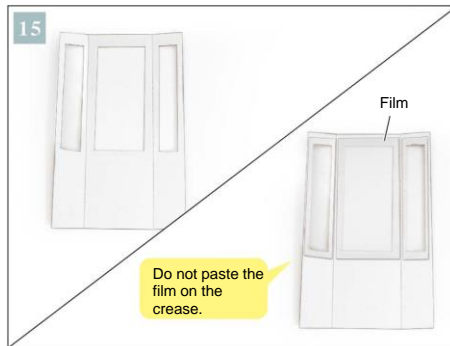
Cut out paper parts.



Paste 14 and 15 together.



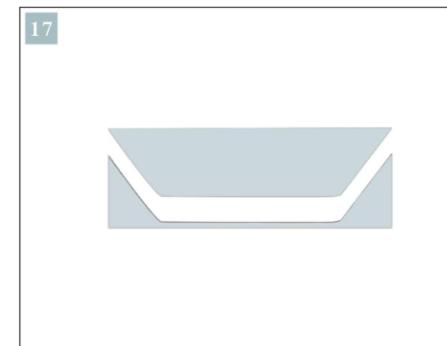
After the glue dries, cut out



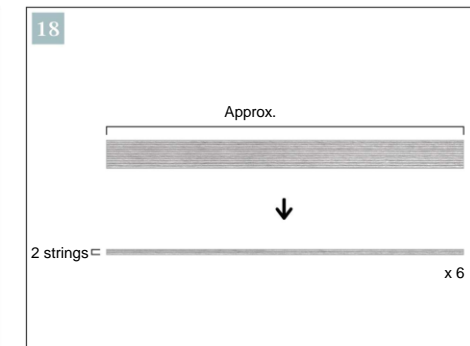
Turn it over, make a crease on the dotted line and fold into a valley shape. Cut the film along the solid lines and paste on it.



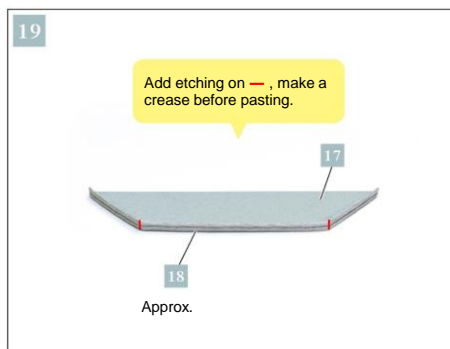
Place 15 and 16 in 11, draw a line on 16 along 15 with a pencil.



Cut along the line.
*The pattern of the paper parts may come off if you rub it with an eraser or wet tissues.



Cut the craft band (gray) into approx. 19cm. Split it as shown in the picture above.



Paste one of the craft band split in 18 on the side of 17. Cut off the excess.
* The rest of craft band will be used in 21.
* Make sure it is the good size in the wooden box before attaching it with the glue.



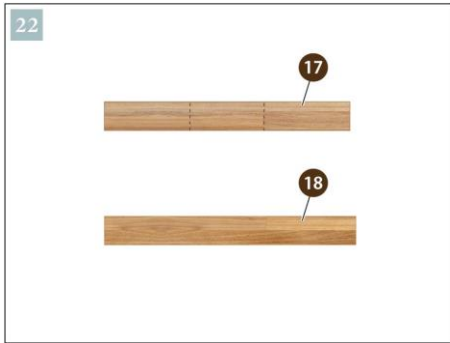
Paste parts together.



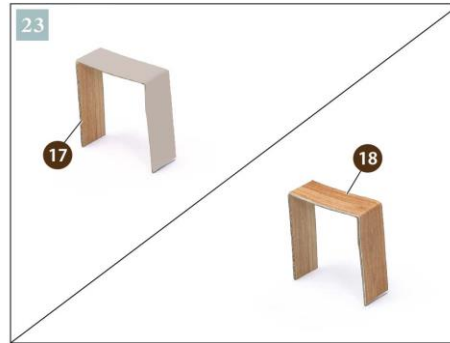
Cut the rest of the craft band cut in 18 along and , and paste them onto the wooden box as shown in the picture above.



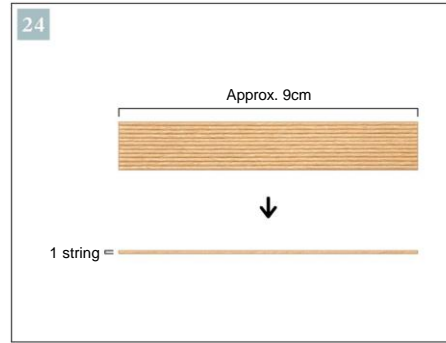
Enlargement



Cut out the paper parts.



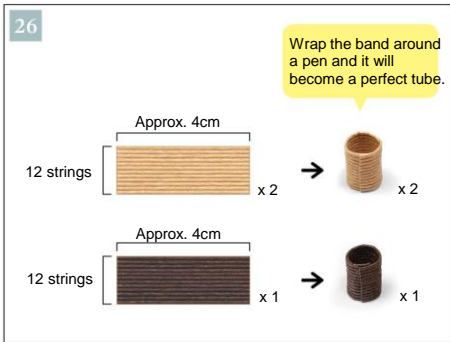
Make a crease on the dotted lines and fold into a valley shape. Paste 18 on 17, cut the excess.



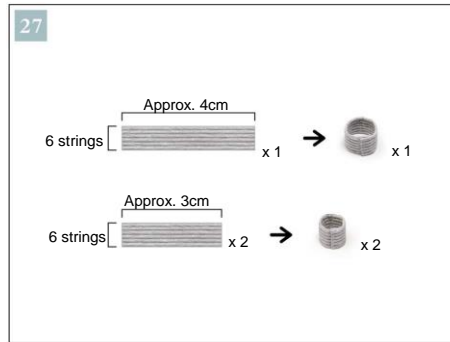
Cut the craft band (beige) into approx. 9cm. Split it as shown in the picture above.



Paste one string of craft band split in 24 along the 23 as shown in the picture above, and cut off the excess.



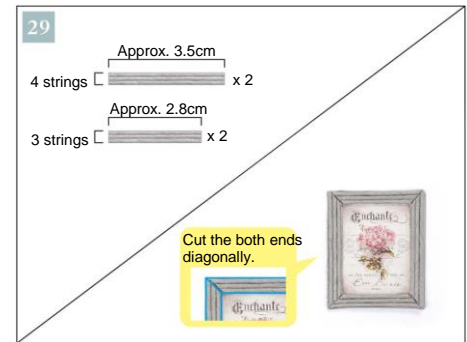
Cut the craft band (beige) into approx. 4cm x 2 pieces. Cut the craft band (brown) into approx. 4cm x 1 piece.



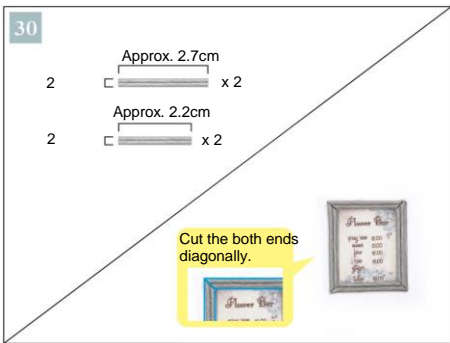
Cut the craft band (gray) into approx. 4cm and 3cm. Split them into smaller pieces as shown in the picture above to make tubes in the same way as 26.



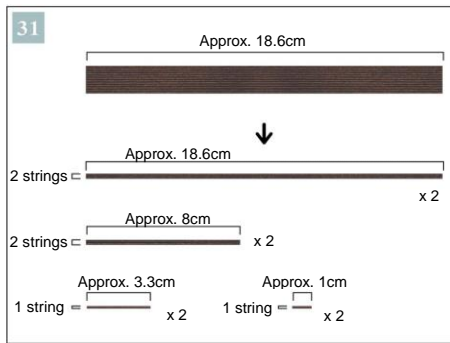
Cut out the paper parts.



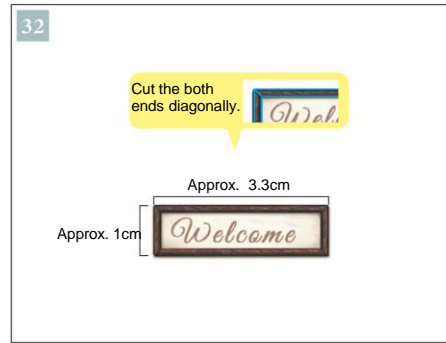
Cut the craft band (gray) into approx. 3.5cm. Split it and paste the bands on 29 as shown in the picture above.



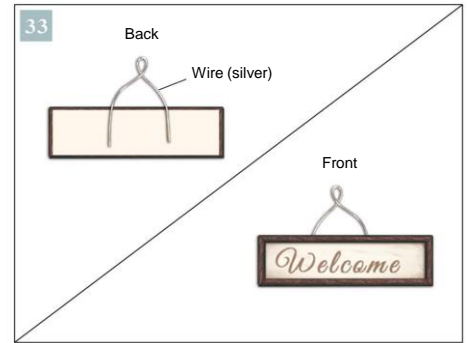
Cut the craft band (gray) into approx. 2.7cm. Split it and paste the bands on 30 as shown in the picture above.



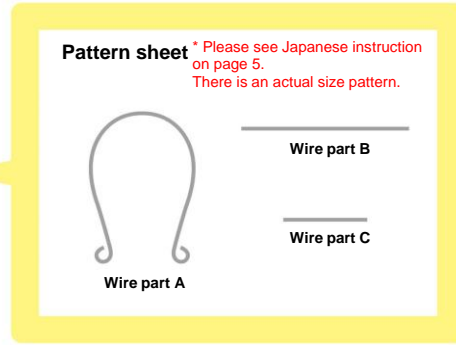
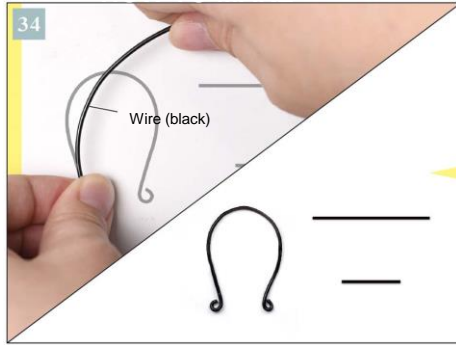
Split the craft band (brown) as shown in the picture above.



Paste the craft band split in 31 (3.3cm and 1cm) on 32. * The rest of craft band will be used in 31.

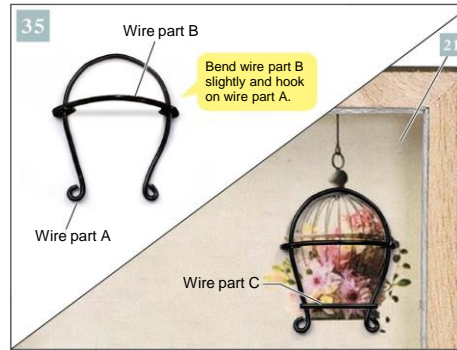


Curve the silver wire, and paste it on the back of 32.



Curve the black wire referring to the pattern sheet.

* Please see Japanese instruction on page 5. There is an actual size pattern.



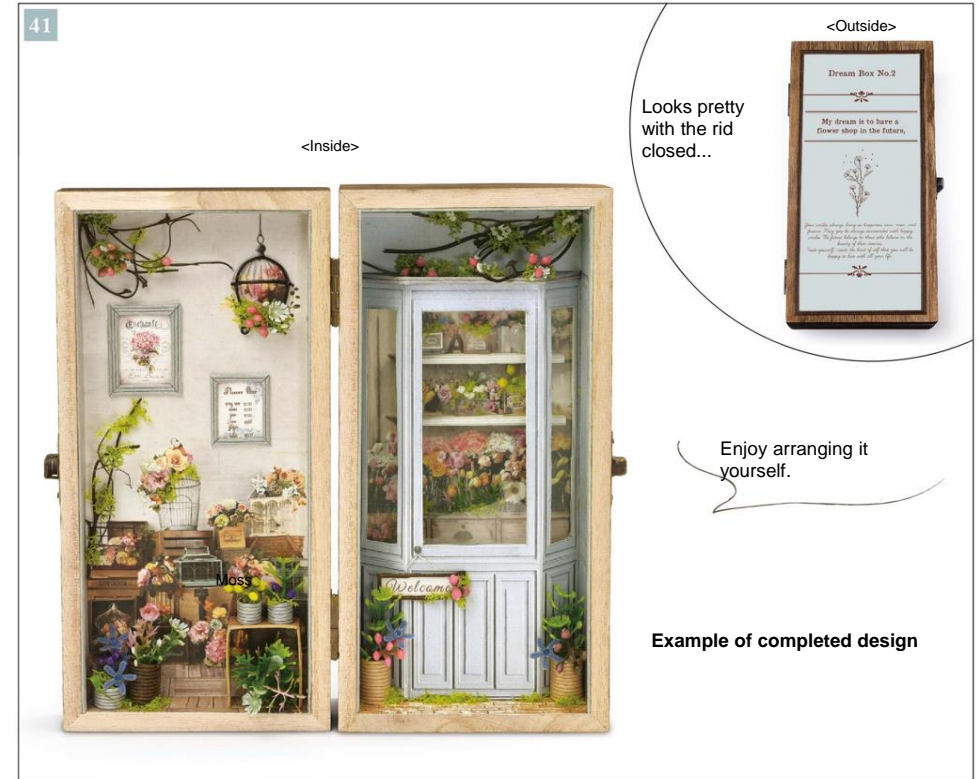
Bend both ends of wire part B and hook on the wire part A. Pinch the joints with flat-nose pliers to fix it. Paste the wire parts on the picture as shown in above. Then, attach the wire part C to it with the glue.



Paste each parts.

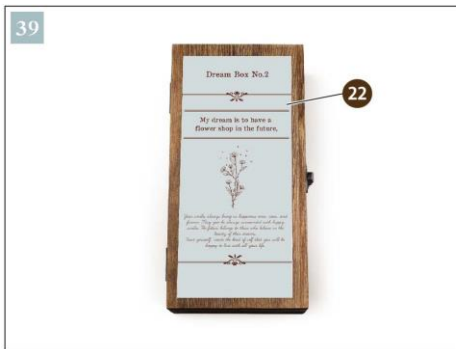


Paste plants as shown in the picture above.
