

[Tools needed]

craft bond glue, utility knife, cutting mat, scissors, tweezers, ruler, pencils, toothpick, nippers, eyeleteer, needle-nose pliers, round-nose pliers, scotch tape

[Not necessary but convenient]

tray for parts, glue stick, wet wipes, papers

[Materials included]



* Image printed on instruction may have a certain level of color difference to the actual object. * The actual object may have certain differences compared with the image printed here. * For materials in this kit, their colors, shapes, sizes and pattern may vary, due to manufacturing process. Natural wooden plate are naturally generated, their colors and wood grain will not be identical. * The wooden plate may be warped slightly because of the excessive humidity.

[About Preserved moss and flowers]

* Preserved moss and flowers may get on your clothes, wall or floor. * if they are exposed to fluorescent light or direct sunshine for long time, the colors may fade. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight. * Depending on the season, the colors, shapes and sizes of moss and flowers may vary. * This product is specially for craft. Do not eat.

Read the following before you start.

* Please check if the contents are all included. * Please follow the TIP, reference information, and images for your reference.

* You will need:

- a wooden stick...to use bond glue.
- a wet towel... to wipe your hands and to clean your place.
- a paper... when using bond glue and not to get dirty.
- tweezers... for detail work.
- A glue gun is also useful instead of a bond glue.

* Please adjust the length of natural flowers and preserved moss based on the place where you want to use it. Divide the materials and dry run before finally fixing to the products.

* Printed images may be come off when rubbing the paper parts with an eraser or a wet towel.

Keep out of reach of children and pets. Maybe harmful if swallowed.

Craft band



12-13 strings

Ensure use the correct color of band for each design element.

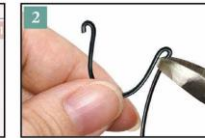
*The craft bands vary slightly in width or the number of twisted paper strings, depending on their colors.

Curve the wire

Bending in the opposite direction which has been bended makes it being deformed or split.



Curve the wire referring to the pattern sheet with your fingers or pliers.



Cut off the excess with nippers.

POINT

Roll into a circle



Wrap it around a pen.

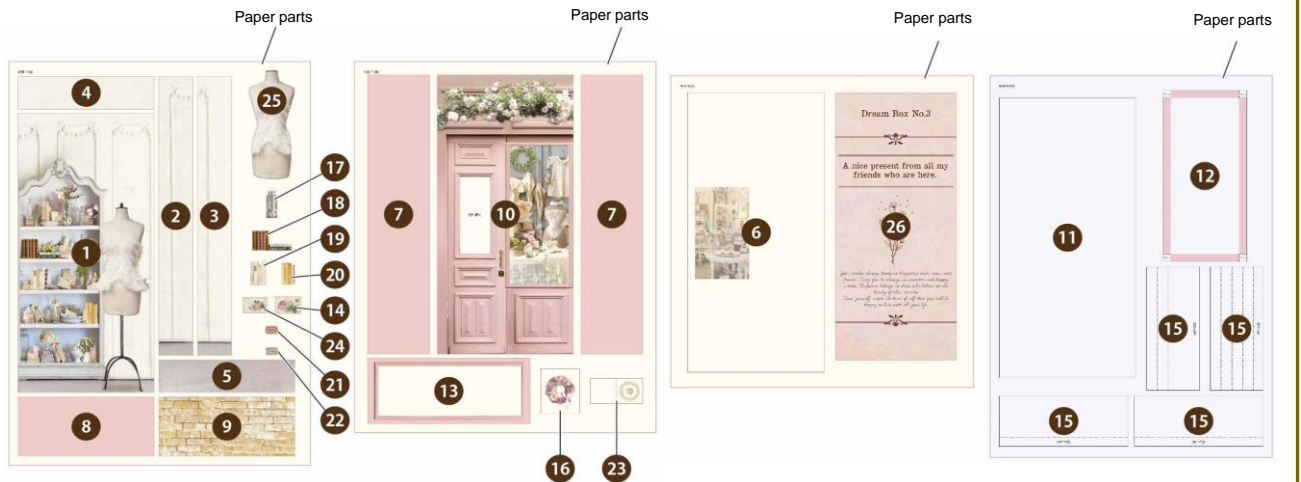
Curve the edge

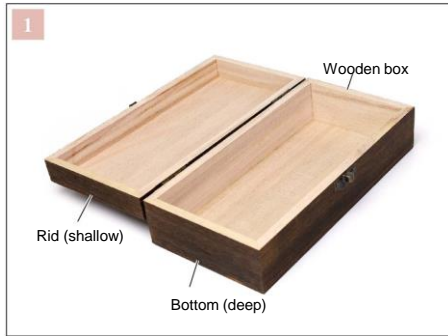


Pinch the edge with pliers and bend it.

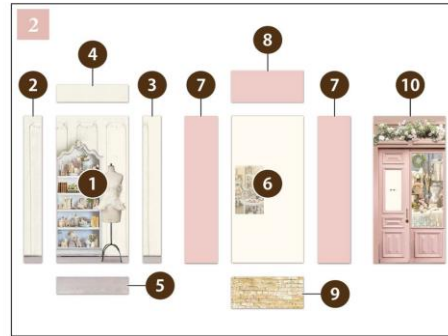
Paste Paper parts on one side.

*When you work on, please refer to the numbers printed here. Only numbers are printed in HOW TO MAKE section instead of part's name.





Unlock the Wooden box and place it with the rid open.
*Place something under the rid so that the rims of the rid and bottom are horizontal.



Cut out paper parts.

POINT Wooden box may be warped because it is a natural product. When pasting paper parts inside the box, measure the sizes where you would like to paste and cut the paper parts to fit them.

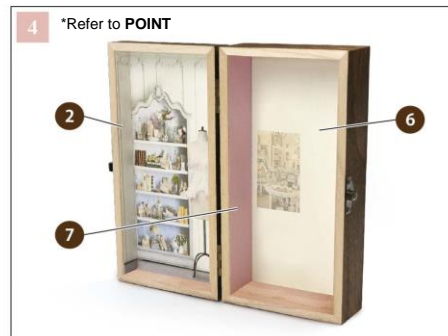
Cut the parts (2~4, 7~8) which will be pasted on 1~2mm shorter than actual size.

Align ★ to the inner corners of the wooden box.

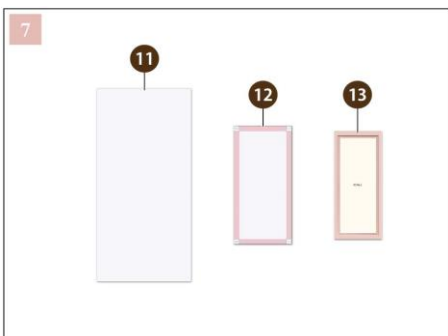
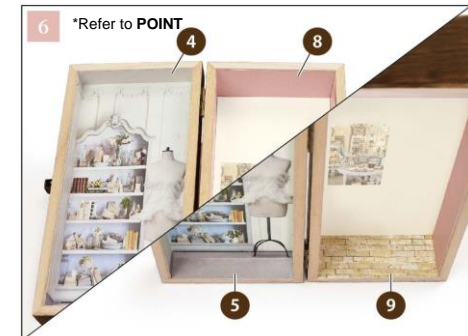
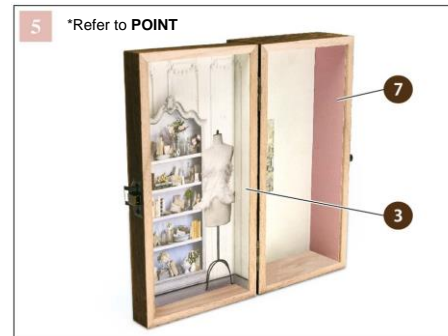
Rid Bottom Paste inside the Paste inside the



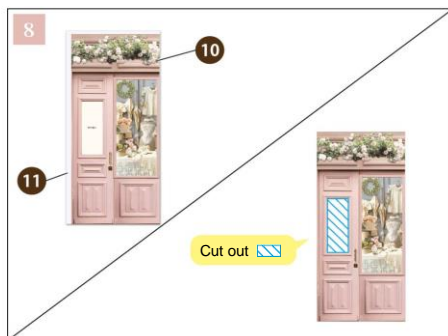
Cut out 1 to fit the size of [diagonal lines].
* It is easier to work in the following process if you cut 10 at the same time.



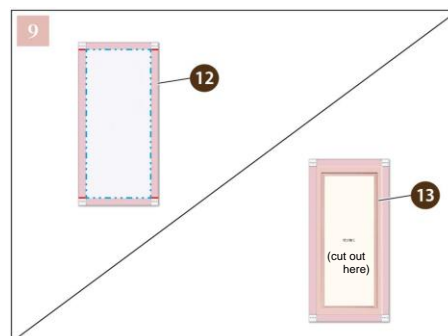
Paste each part in the same way as 4.



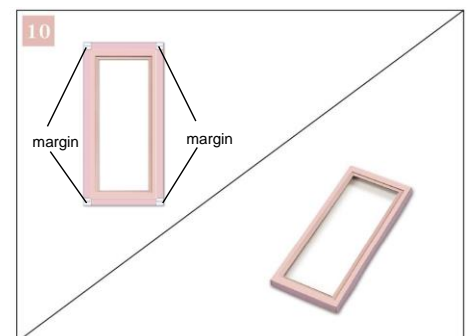
Cut out paper parts.



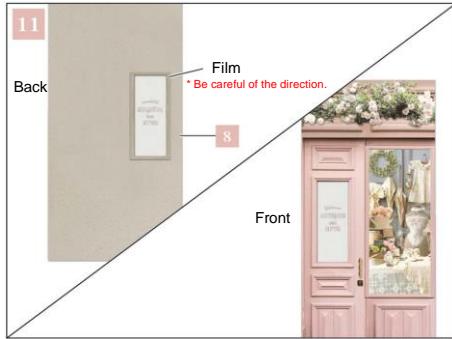
Paste 10 on 11, and cut 11 to fit 10.



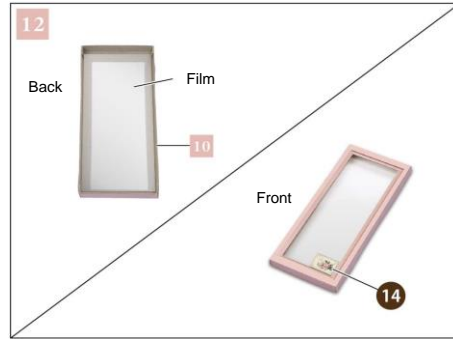
Add notches on — of 12, and make a crease on - - - and fold into a mountain shape. Paste 13 in the center of 12.



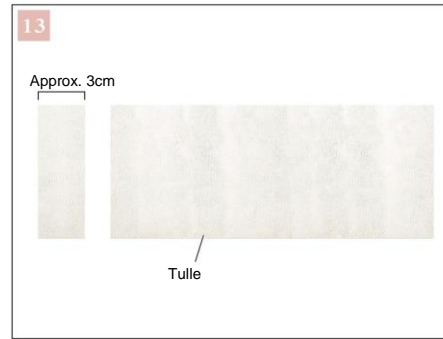
After the glue dries, cut out the window frame. Apply the glue on the margins and paste together.



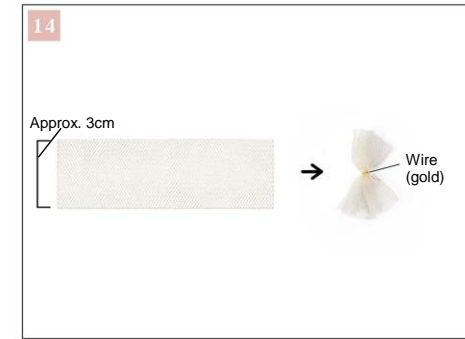
Paste the film on the back of 11.



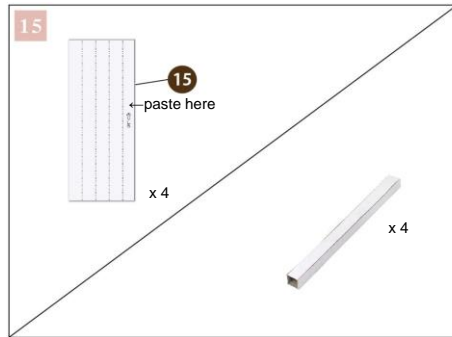
Paste the film on the back of 10. Cut out 10, and paste it on the front.



Cut tulle lace into two pieces as shown in the picture above.



Wrap the gold wire around the tulle lace several times as shown in the picture above, and twist the excess a few times. Create a tiny dress.



Cut out 15, make a crease on the dotted lines and fold it into a mountain shape. Apply glue on the margins and paste together.



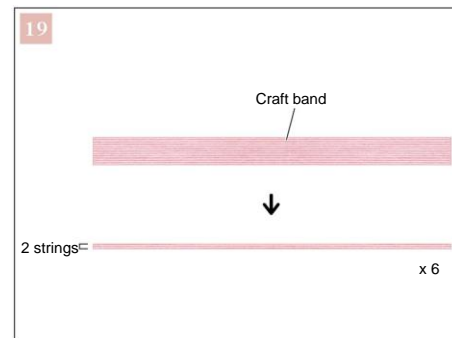
Paste 15 on 6.



Apply the glue to 19, and paste 11 onto it.



Paste parts together.
* Lace will also be used in 21, plants will also be used in 17~18.
* Cut plants into appropriate lengths depending on the spot you would like to attach. Divide them into some bunches for your convenience.



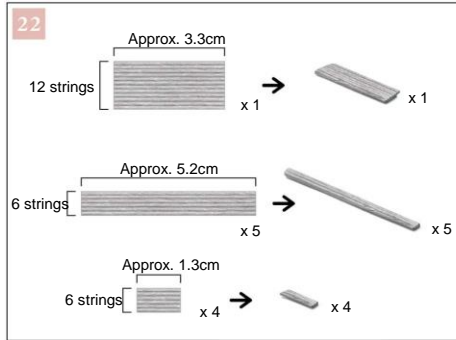
Cut out the pink craft band as shown in the picture above.



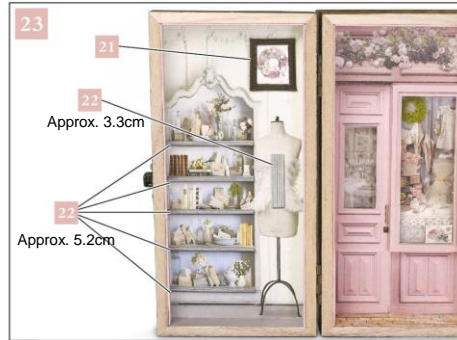
Cut 19 to fit in [blue box] and [red box], and paste the bands onto them.



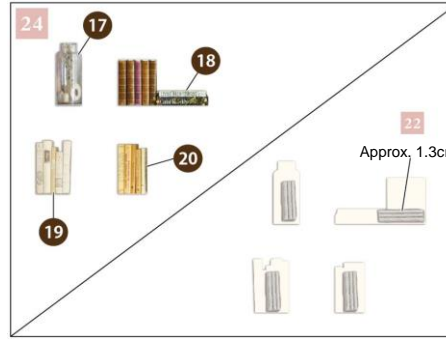
Cut out 16.
Cut a craft band into approx. 3.2cm and split them as shown in the picture above. Then, paste them on 16.



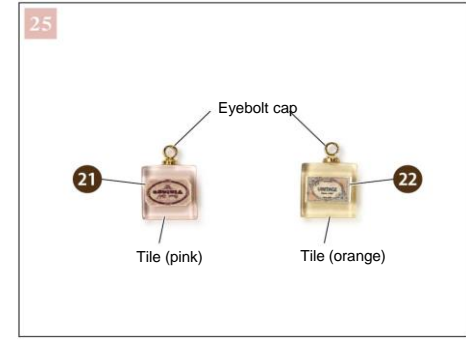
Cut out the gray craft band into approx. 3.3cm x 1, approx. 5.2cm x 3pieces. Split them as shown in the picture above. Apply the glue and fold them in half.



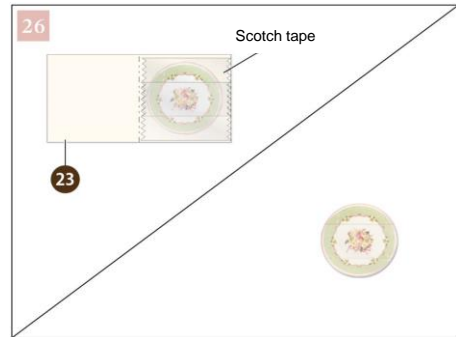
Paste parts together.



Cut out the paper parts, and paste 22 on the back of them.



Cut out the paper parts, and paste the parts and tiles together.



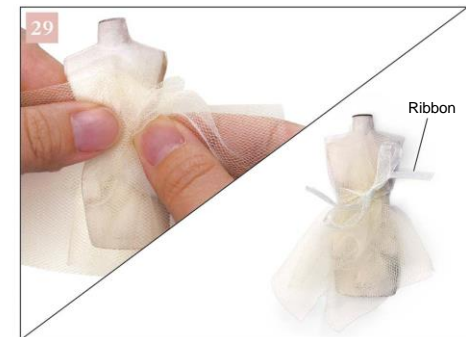
Cut out 23, and paste scotch tape on the pattern. Make a crease on the dotted lines, and fold it into a mountain shape. After pasting it with the glue, cut out along the patterns.



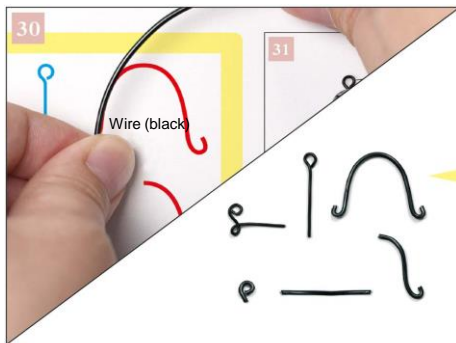
Cut out 24, and paste parts together.



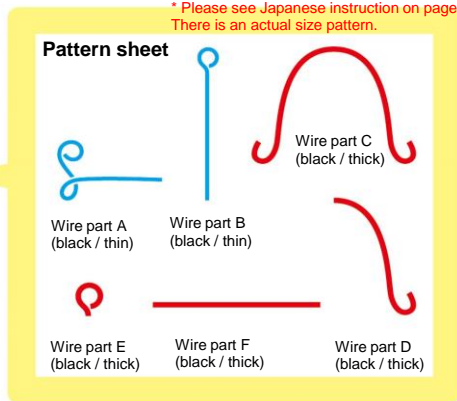
Cut out 25. Fold the tulle lace cut 15 into 1/3. Then put 25 onto it.



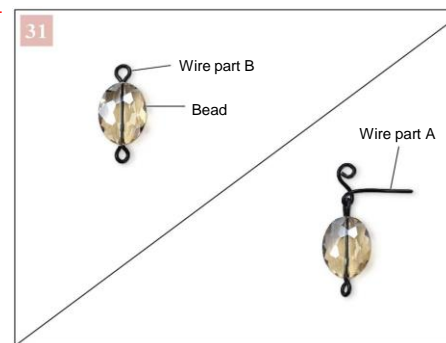
Making frills on the tulle lace and wrap it around 25. Wrap a ribbon on it and tie in a butterfly knot. * Cut the ribbon into appropriate length as you like.



Curve the wire referring to the pattern sheet. * There are two types of wire (black). Blue is the thin one, red is the thick one in the pattern sheet.



* Please see Japanese instruction on page 4. There is an actual size pattern.



Put the wire part B through the bead and curve the edges and connect it to the wire part A as shown in the picture above.

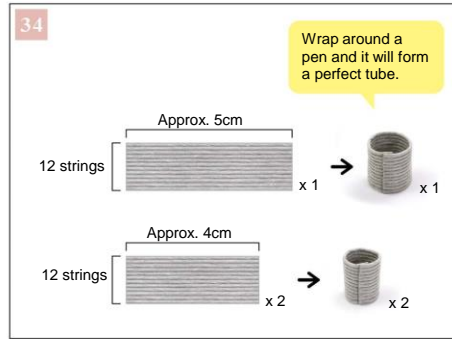


Punch a hole with an eyelet on the spot as shown in the above. Put 31 into the hole.

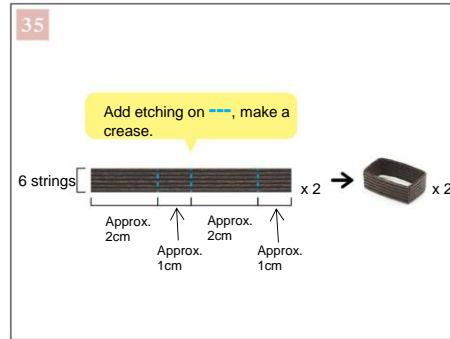

Paste parts together.



Cut the gray craft band into approx.5cm x 1 and approx. 4cm x 2pieces. Split them as shown in the picture above to make tubes.



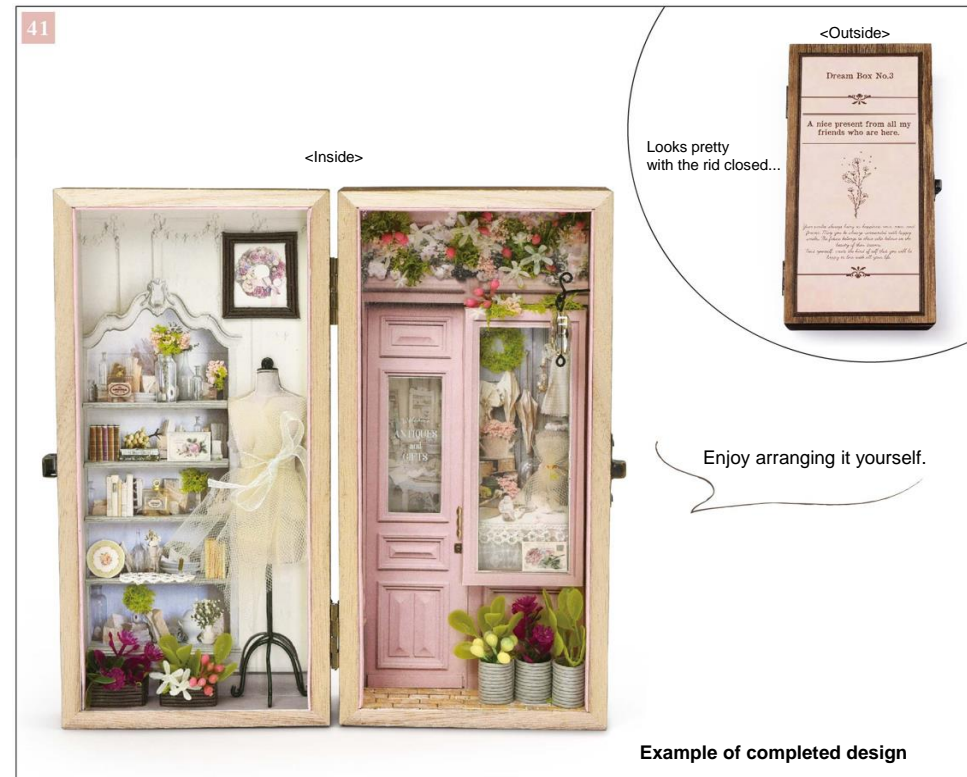
Cut the dark brown craft band into approx. 6cm. Fold it as shown in the picture above to make parts.



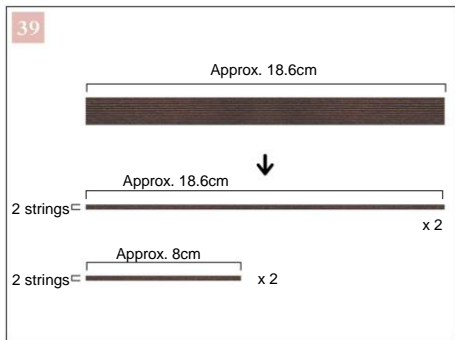
Paste parts together.



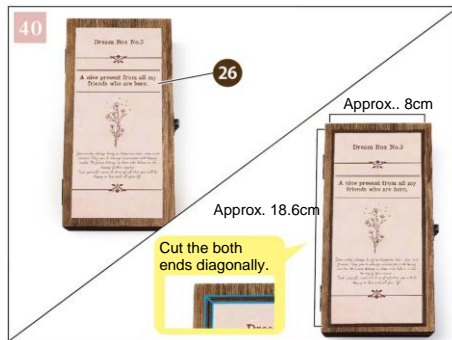
Paste the plants.

Cut the brown craft band, and split them as shown in the above.



Cut out 26 and paste on the lid of the wooden box. Paste 39 around 26.
